VOCATIONAL NURSING LEADERSHIP PATHWAY

This pathway allows LVNs to gain teaching credentials and pursue associate, bachelor's, and master's degrees while teaching, graduating debt-free with an advanced degree and valuable higher education experience.

ALLIED HEALTH LEADERSHIP PATHWAY

This apprenticeship program, aimed at allied health professionals seeking leadership roles, allows diploma-level faculty to obtain a master's degree in as little as 10 years.

VOCATIONAL NURSING TO DOCTOR OF NURSING PRACTICE LEADERSHIP PATHWAY

This pathway is designed for LVNs aiming to enhance their clinical skills and educator roles, guiding them from RN certification to obtaining a BSN and MSN

- Teach for 1 year after acquiring each credential
- Split time between teaching & clinicals for 2 years
- Teach full time in a BSN program for 4 years after completing coursework

ELIGIBILITY AND TERMS:

Must meet all admissions requirements to enroll in the selected program.

The employee must be in good performance standing with the company, maintain an employment status of a full-time, part-time, or per-diem employee while in the program, and have been employed with Unitek a minimum of six months prior to the program start date.

Employee must remain and maintain his/her employment status after graduation for the specified period of time based on the type of program completed (1 year for diploma certificate; 2 years for Associate's Degree; and 3 years for Bachelor's/Master's Degree).

Remain in good performance standing to retain eligibility - meet all the expectations for his or her job and not have performance issues, including performance write-ups, corrective actions, or Performance Improvement Plans

Due to seat availability, a selection and ranking process may apply in the event the program is at capacity. The ranking and selection process will be based on various factors including employee performance evaluation.

Must remain in good academic standing and pass course for tuition to be forgiven.

The forgiveness is for tuition only, all books and supplies will be the responsibility of the employee.

For tuition forgiveness, after graduation from the program, the applicable percentage of tuition is forgiven over a period of time based on degree, while recipients working at the same status as when the employee was in the program. Employees can increase status but cannot decrease. For example, go from part-time to full time but not full-time to part-time.
